Teri Larson received her undergraduate degrees from Saint Olaf College in Northfield, Minnesota where she studied under Dr. Kenneth Jennings, former director of the St. Olaf Choir, Robert Scholz and Alice T. Larsen. She received her Masters in Choral Conducting and Literature from Saint Cloud State University, St. Cloud, Minnesota. She is currently serving her fifteenth year as Choral Director and Director of Music at the Basilica of Saint Mary in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

Ms. Larson is the founder of three children's choirs at the Basilica, Angelicum Women's Choir, and directs a semi-professional Schola Cantorum. Ms. Larson has served as contest adjudicator, festival chorus director at numerous choral festivals, and is a member of ACDA, the National Association of Pastoral Musicians, Choristers Guild, the American Federation of Pueri Cantores and the Conference of Roman Catholic Cathedral Musicians. She has served as the Repertoire and Standards Chair for Worship in the Minnesota Central Division Chapter of ACDA, served a three year tenure as the Twin Cities Chapter President of Choristers Guild. She currently serves on the Board of Directors for Choristers Guild. She resides in Maple Grove, Minnesota with her husband, Don Krubsack and children, Jeff and Ellan.
